Lina Murel Jardorf is a 39 year old painter and sculpturer from Copenhagen, Denmark.

Spirituality of the art

Lina Murel Jardorf is renowned for her vivid colours and vibrant expression. "When my brush touches the canvas I am not totally in control of the result. I don't know the motif and the colours until they emerge. I never plan – I just let it happen.

It is an extraordinary process Most of it comes to me as a gift from the universe and I never stop wondering how".

But Lina Murel Jardorf is not only a painter. "Just recently I took up bronze sculpturing and again the same story. The clay seems to unfold its own spirit and live its own life, and when the final bronze sculptures breaks out of the moulding box, each of them seems to have a personality of their own".

Lina Murel Jardorf has established a studio in the heart of New York. "But, my primary studio is at the hayloft of an old barn in Holte in Denmark. I just love the contrast between the tranquillity of the countryside and the noise of Broadway.
